

HAND DISINFECTANT

Gel-like hand disinfectant

APPLICATIONS

Hygienic hand disinfection: The product is suitable for healthcare, the food industry, daycare centers and other settings where washing with soap is insufficient or not possible.

Surgical hand disinfection: For surgical hand disinfection, the product should be used in accordance with international or local guidelines. See instructions for use.

FEATURES

This product is alcohol-based. Its active ingredient is ethanol and the denaturants are isopropanol and t-butanol. The product is moisturizing and very gentle on the skin thanks to the added glycerin.

EFFICACY

Fast and effective

- Broad-spectrum efficacy against bacteria (10 times more effective than washing with soap and water)
- Good efficacy against viruses
- Good efficacy against TB
- Effective against fungi
- Not effective against spores

CLASSIFICATION

This hand sanitizer for hygienic hand disinfection is classified as a biocidal product in accordance with Regulation (EU) No. 528/2012 - PT1.

INGREDIENTS

Active ingredients:

Ethanol (70% w/w), Propan-2-ol (10% w/w).

Other ingredients:

Aqua, Glycerin (humectant), t-Butyl Alcohol (denaturant), Carbomer (thickener), Aminomethyl Propanol (thickener).

Contains alcohol: 80% w/w, 85% v/v

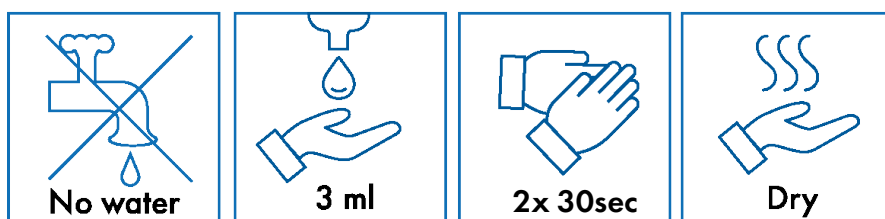
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INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

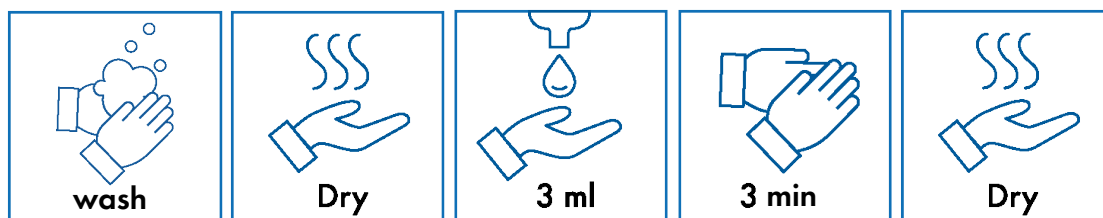
Hygienic hand disinfection:

Your hands must always be completely dry before applying hand sanitizer. Cup your hand and dispense at least 3 ml of hand sanitizer (2 small pumps). Carefully spread the sanitizer all over your hands. Start at the fingertips and continue to the fingers and thumbs. Rub it into your wrists and, if necessary, your forearms. Continue rubbing until the solution has evaporated and your skin feels dry again. Ensure that you rub hand disinfectant into your hands for at least 2 × 30 seconds during hygienic hand disinfection. Repeat the procedure if necessary.



Surgical Hand Sanitization:

1. Before applying hand sanitizer, pre-wash your hands and forearms with liquid soap. Dry your hands and forearms thoroughly using disposable paper towels.
2. Ensure that you rub the sanitizer into your hands for at least 3 minutes for surgical hand sanitization.
3. There are many ways to prepare the hands, nails and forearms before performing surgical procedures. These instructions are just one example of the recommendations. For surgical hand disinfection, follow local guidelines.



Surgical gloves breaking during the procedure:

If surgical gloves break during the procedure, they must be removed. Your hands may easily become contaminated. Use a hand disinfectant as instructed above.
